Voices of Passion

The Meljon Singers bring you an eclectic programme of music from both western and eastern choral traditions. Stanford's superb *Three Motets* sit alongside unjustly neglected pieces such as Edmund Rubbra's *Mass in Honorem Sancti Dominici* and Britten's *Chorale after an old French carol* while pieces by Rachmaninov, Sviridov, Tchaikovsky and others demonstrate the flowering of Russian sacred choral music with its rich vocal harmonies.

Cellist Christopher Slatter enjoys a busy and varied schedule which includes work with the Kingfisher Sinfonietta, the Prometheus Orchestra and the Scintillo String Quartet. In Tavener's profoundly moving *Soyati* with its virtuoso 'cello part and Bennett's equally moving *A Farewell to Arms*, the instrument combines with the voices to create a unique sound-world, complementing, interweaving and occasionally soaring above them.

In addition to the performance, your evening will feature a complimentary programme and an interval when refreshments will be served.
